

Dear Consumer:

Thank you for contacting the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, Lemon Law Unit, regarding your Chrysler, Dodge or Jeep vehicle.

We are pleased to inform our consumers that the auto manufacturer has emerged from bankruptcy on June 10th as a new company, Chrysler Group, LLC, and that we are now able to schedule hearings for those that qualify for Lemon Law relief.

Due to Chrysler's filing for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy protection on April 30th, 2009, the Lemon Law Unit was unable to schedule any hearings for its consumers who filed Lemon Law applications. As part of the bankruptcy protection, all judicial, administrative or other proceedings were stayed, meaning they were suspended or put on hold.

The Lemon Law Unit wants to assure consumers that all Lemon Law applications submitted to the unit will now be reviewed for eligibility as normal. For more complete details on the Lemon Law process, we encourage you to review our <u>Consumer Brief</u>.
